USE OF VIDEO CAMERAS IN COMPETITION CARS
AT THRUXTON, PEMBREY, MALLORY PARK and CROFT CIRCUITS

Permission must be granted in advance of the meeting by the Press Office at Thruxton Circuit before a competitor may install a video camera in his/her car. This applies to any meetings run at Thruxton, Pembrey, Mallory Park and Croft Circuits. When you have completed the form below, please return it to The Press Office, British Automobile Racing Club, Thruxton Circuit, Andover, Hants, SP11 8PN, for signing, whereupon it will be returned and must then be retained by the competitor for further signatures from the Examining Scrutineer and Race Director/Clerk of the Course on the day of the meeting.

Depending on the purpose for which the video is to be used, a fee may be charged. If charged, this fee must be paid prior to the meeting but is refundable in the event of the car not passing scrutineering.
